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Research Skills Lecture 4

Dr. Paromita, H.R. College

Dr. Paromita Chakrabarti is Associate Professor of English and Director, Global Research Initiatives (GRI) at H.R. College of Commerce and Economics, University of Mumbai where she has been teaching since 2001. Her research areas include migration, diaspora, postcolonial studies, gender and nation. She has published several articles in international journals and is the assistant editor of the peer reviewed journal Writing Today: International Journal of Studies in English. She has been a joint editor for the peer reviewed journal Baltic Worlds from Södertörn University, Stockholm and has been a resource person at University Grants Commission (UGC) sponsored refresher courses. She annually teaches a Master's level seminar class on Feminist Critical Theory at the University of Sheffield, and has been an invited speaker for seminar lecture at several universities and colleges both in India and abroad. In her spare time Paromita enjoys trekking and travelling.

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Report : Lecture by Dr Paromita Chakraborty on "Potential Research Areas: Gender Studies, Postcolonialism & Diaspora"

The fourth day of Research guidance session was held on 10th February 2021 by Dr Paromita Chakraborty, HR College. She started the research session by emphasizing on the importance of a research theory and its benefits. Students learned the way in which literature could be appreciated by appling a literary theory. The entire session was divided into two parts. The first part of the session focused on Feminist Literary Criticism. The different branches of Feminist criticism such as French Feminist criticism, Gynocriticism, Psychoanalysis and encounter of Marxism were introduced. Students were asked to differentiate between oppression and exploitation with the help of day to day examples. Students were familiarized with the use of memoirs, journals, diaries and cookbooks as a part of literary search for lost women. Dr Paromita suggested students to read books by Gayatri Chakravorty Spivak, Mary Eagleton and Jack Halberstam to understand feminism better. The second session consisted of a brief talk on migration, diaspora and postcolonial theory. The behaviour of the colonised and the coloniser was defined by D. Paromita with the example of E. M. Forster's works. The term 'Homing Desire' by Avtar Brah was explained in detail stating the desires of immigrants to experience home while living in a foreign host land. The interactive two hour session ended with Dr Paromita answering queries from student participants and finally with a vote of thanks by students. 21 students participated in the session.
