Dr. Dinesh Kumar is an Associate Professor, Department of English. Dr. Dinesh Kumar has a Doctoral degree in African American Literature, from the University of Mumbai. His areas of Specialization are Literary Theory and African American Literature. His research interests and research supervision include Critical Race Theory, Mexican Fiction, Mash-up Fiction, Chinese-American Fiction, Trauma Studies, Masculinity Studies, Cultural Politics, Cultural Citizenship, Indo-Caribbean Writers, Migration Studies, Memory Studies, Media Memory, Pakistani Women Writers, Eco-criticism, Ecofeminism, Spatial Criticism, Geo-poetics, Textual Democracy, Chaos Theory, Neo Diasporas, Cyber Criticism and Cultural Diplomacy. He has presented about 20 research papers and published articles in international peer reviewed Journals such as Atlantic Quarterly, University News, Research Spectrum, Research Drops, European Academic Research, Virtuoso and in Critical Anthologies on Alice Walker, Amitav Ghosh, G.V. Desani, Kamala Das and South Asian Literature. World War I: Centenary Hindsights is recent book. He has also co-authored and edited three books for the University of Mumbai - Linguistic and Stylistic Analysis of Texts, Translation Studies and Literary Theory. He has been teaching at the Undergraduate and Postgraduate levels for 22 years and has guided 22 students for their M.Phil. Degrees. 8 scholars are working with him for their Doctoral Degrees. He has also been the resource person and keynote speaker in various national and international conferences. # Lecture by Dr Dinesh Kumar on "Dynamics of Research in English- I"

The Research guidance lectures started off from 1<sup>st</sup> February 2021. The first lecture in the series was delivered by Dr Dinesh Kumar, Vaze College. The session started with an introduction to a formula for a perfect 'Research Title'. The entire session was divided into two different parts. The first part of the session covered the importance of an attractive Research title. Dr Dinesh showcased three different ways in which students could frame a research title revolving around a single novel and a literary theory. The students were amazed to learn the way in which three different titles could be created around the same research area. In the second session Dr Dinesh introduced the different areas that students could use for their research work. The areas ranged from the study of Comparative literature to the application of various theories to Art, Films and other literary works. Further, students were introduced to sixteen potential areas of research in detail. Students were benefited as they came across some new research areas such as Spirituality, Journalism and Mash up Fiction. The use of PPT slides by Dr Dinesh made the session more interactive and valuable. The session ended with Dr Dinesh solving student's queries revolving around the use of theories on various novels. 19 students were present for this session.


