# Report of Lecture by Dr Lakshmi Muthukumar on "Disability Studies: Theory & Potential for Research"

The third day of Research guidance session was held on 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021. Dr. LakshmimiMuthukumar, HoD, English,SIES College introduced the research area of Disability Studies. The lecture on "Disability Studies: Theory and Potential for Research" was initiated with an introduction to the Social Model of Disability by Union of Physically Impaired against Segregation. She outlined the innumerable ways through which the disabled became the oppressed group. A detailed insight was provided into Disability Discrimination Act of 1995 which connected the disabled groups with many institutions through control over media, infrastructural changes, public transportation and awareness. To make the session more interesting, students were split in teams of four. Separate break out rooms for teams were created on Zoom platform. The time limit given for discussion was five minutes. After the discussion each team was given a chance to explain the disabled character in the film or novel selected by them. Each team brought up many characters from different films and novels. This exercise gave students an exposure to a new area of research. Students were suggested to read books on Disability studies by Lennard J. Davis and Colin Cameron. The interactive session ended with a vote of thanks by the students. 23 students participated actively in the session.




