# Report of the Inauguration of the Activities of English Literary Association& Summary Writing Competition:

The activities of English Literary Association were inaugurated with a talk on "Literature: Add to your values and Value" by ShriShripadSamant, Asst. Professor, Mithibai college on September 22, 2020. On the occasion, the first activity of the Association, a summary writing competition based on the talk of the speaker was also conducted. The speaker evoked imagery of World War II and pleaded for the outcome of education to be humanity rather than production of learned monsters, skilled psychopaths, and educated illiterates. He explained that literature brings History alive and teaches us the values that we might have forgotten. He explained how literature is the vehicle used by Freedom fighters, Biologists and Politicians to spread their thoughts. He argued that writing was the window to the world and gave the instance of a Native American quote "We do not get any land from our Ancestors, we borrow it from our children" to show how literature enables us to approach the whole world sitting at one point. He further emphasized that Literature gives us a vocabulary, makes us global citizens and improves our communication skills. Further, as with Literature, sky is the limit, he surmised that literature as a constituent of education makes us better human beings. Literature students from FYBA, SYBA and TYBA were present on this occasion.
