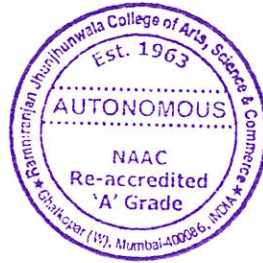

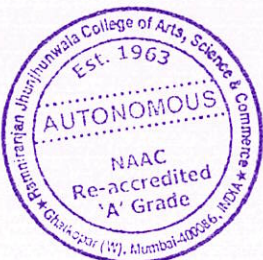
Objectives:

Learning Outcomes:

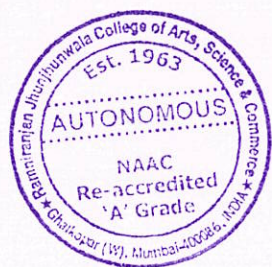
1. To understand the complex process of Best Practices of NAAC with ease.

Twenty-Eight prominent academicians and administrators acted as Resources Persons. Following was the schedule of the event:



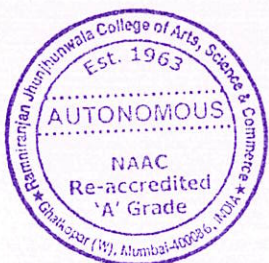
