ANNUAL REPORT SES-REC (2020-2021)

In the month of August, 2020 R J College of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomous) registered itself and became a Recognised Social Entrepreneurship, Swachhta and Rural Engagement Cell (SES-REC) Institution under the Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Government of India. Under the SES-REC Action Plan, our Institution constituted Ten working groups for improving facilities in the Campus and the Community/ Adopted villages in the areas of sanitation and Hygiene, Waste Management, Water Management, Energy Conservation and Greenery. It also intended along with this, observation of three environment, entrepreneurship and community engagement related days to inculcate in faculty, students and community, the practices of Mentoring, Social responsibility, Swachhta and Care for Environment and Resources.

On 10th March 2021, the committee members of SES- REC along with participant students of REDC attended an online Google Meet meeting organised by Team REDC, Ministry of Education, Govt. Of India. The convenor of the Programme was Dr. Bhavesh Jasani. The meeting was attended by 07 teacher members and 20 participant students. A proforma e-link for Business Plan was circulated earlier. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss about the Business Plan and give an idea of the competition ahead. The RED Cell of the college was required to conduct Intra collegiate Business Plan competition amongst the student participants and select and nominate three entries who would represent the college at the Cluster level intercollegiate Competition. The task for this purpose was entrusted to Dr. Baisakhi Dutta, who was ably supported by her REDC committee members as well as other teacher staff. On 18th March, 2021, a zoom online meeting was organised and of the 15 students who attended 04 student participants volunteered to take part and prepare the Business Plan. Taking out precious time from their schedule, both the teacher members of REDC as well these 04 students, carried out their task whole heartedly following the guidelines given by these teachers on a separate whatsapp group formed for this purpose. The RED Cell (REDC) of R J College would like to thank and appreciate Dr. Vilasini Patkar, Professor and Head, Department of Commerce, for her guidance and later the help provided in judging the participants in the Intracollegiate Business Plan competition. Once ready, the competition was held online on Zoom on 5th April, 2021 at 4 pm. In here the participants were supposed to give a powerpoint presentation alongwith the talk, for 10 minutes on the set proforma of their Business Plan. Finally, 03 participants were selected and their details sent to REDC, GoI, for further process. The response from them is still

Under the SES-REC, the committee members of the 10 working groups, through their respective associations and departments carried out various programmes related to Water Conservation, Energy Conservation, Sanitisation and Hygiene, Waste Management, Green Campus either in the form of E-quiz, Poster Competition, Field visit, Campus activity.

1. Water, Waste and Energy Management E-Quiz Activity
Water, Waste and Energy management intra collegiate E-quiz was organized for the students of all the streams (undergraduate and postgraduate) on 19th April 2021 through a combined activity of associations such as Water management campus (Dr. Deepali Pimple), Water management community/adopted villages (Dr. Manisha Bhattacharya), Waste management campus and community/adopted villages (Dr. Palak Chawla) and Energy management campus and community/adopted villages (Dr. Amol Kadam) The aim was to spread awareness among the students concerning water, waste products and energy management. It was an online open book multiple choice quiz to make them dig into the information of these managements and also students could assess themselves with the correct answer, as the motive was to strengthen their knowledge regarding these precious



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resources (water and energy) and suitable ways of waste management. In total **536 students** participated from different subject streams (Arts, Science and Commerce).

On October 30th, 2020, 56 students participated in online powerpoint presentation on 'Environmental Awareness' about Water Conservation & Benefits of Indoor Plants.


